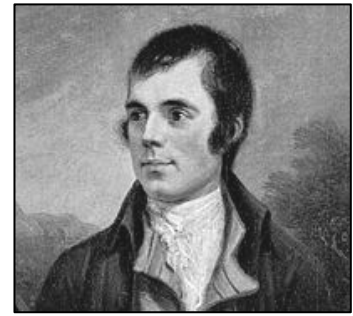

We will celebrate Scotland's favorite son, the romantic poet Robert Burns.

**Dress:** Come in your family tartan, ready to dance a reel, recite a line, propose a toast, or just enjoy the winter warmth of good friends.

Robert Burns lived 1759 to 1796, so attire of that time is appropriate. But don't despair if your 18<sup>th</sup> c. wardrobe is still at the dressmakers. The country folk loved Burns as much as those of the town. You can come in your plain breeches and shirt or your jumps and skirt. You could be a visiting Royal from England, or a Celtic tribesman from the Highland dale.

**Event:** The meal will be fully catered by Madre's Kitchen. All dishes and cups provided by the dames of the church. Some beverages included, although you may supplement with your own. Alcohol allowed but not provided.

Music will be by the Philip Wilkerson Quartet. Dancing will be led by the music mistress, Elinor Vandegrift of Royal Scottish Country Dancers. Piper Kevin Auld will provide the evening with its ritual ceremony and harken back to the days of William Wallace, Robert the Bruce, and the glorious days of Scottish history.
